

Explanation to competitors on the group numbers.

- Groups will have a letter and a number. Each letter group is divided into two sub-groups.
- The letter is your competitor group. The number is your dog's sub-group.

- The number sub-group **ONLY MATTERS FOR GAMBLE** and corresponds to the ring the dog will be running in.
- For Jumpers and Regular, the "Letter" groups will run in the same rings. For example, all A's, B's, C's will run in the same Jumpers and Regular ring, etc. The dog sub-group will not matter.

How Gamble will work:

- There are two Gamble rings - Gamble Ring 1 and Gamble Ring 2.
- The Gamble course will be the same in both rings.
- Dogs in Groups A1, B1, C1, D1, E1, F1 will run in Gamble Ring 1.
- Dogs in Groups A2, B2, C2, D2, E2, F2 will run in Gamble Ring 2.
- Handlers with multiple dogs in Specials and Vets or multiple dogs in Regulars may have to run in both rings. If this applies to you, rest assured you will get to walk both rings and although we are planning to avoid conflicts, we will adjust the running order as needed so you get to run your dogs.

Here are the tentative rotations.
